## **ëstic** Installation Guide

Organize the received panels in alignment with your intended design concept. You may customize the color combinations of your specific set of panels to suit your design.

After finalizing your design, you may start application of double-sided tape to the panels. Ensure that the double-sided tape is applied to the side of the panel you wish to keep concealed

**3.** Double-sided tape is to be applied on all corners of the panel to ensure a strong hold. Also ensure that the wall surface is dust-free before the wall panel installation.



Proper measurement and alignment of the panels should be done prior to wall surface attachment. Attach as planned and there you have it!



Additionally, a spacer tool is provided in case there is need to add even gaps in your design.



## **ëstic** Cleaning & Care Guide

General Care	Light vacuuming on a regular basis will prevent dust build up. Ensure to only use a soft brush attachment with low suction function.
	Periodic dusting may also be required. You may dust with a soft cloth to maintain panel appearance. Avoid severe abrasion on the panel.
Spot Cleaning	Spills, marks and stains should be treated as soon as possible. Blot away any excessive moisture from spills off the material as quickly as possible.
	Most marks can be cleaned with mild detergent and warm water solution but avoid using excessive amounts of water or other cleaning agent/liquids. Note that we do not recommend using solvent based cleaners. Ensure panel can dry through adequate ventilation.
	Use blotting technique with minimal pressure and avoid excessive rubbing. Note to take extra precaution when cleaning dark coloured panels.
Handling & Storage	When handling panels, be sure your hands are clean and free of any contaminants or oils. Keep dust, dirt and liquids of any kind away from all edges and faces of panels at all times.
	Panels must be stored in dry locations/indoors, away from any heating sources. Do not allow water to come into direct contact with the panels. Moisture exposure can cause material to warp, stain or delaminate.
